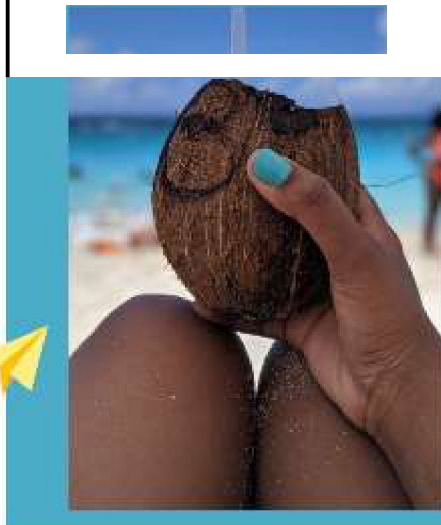
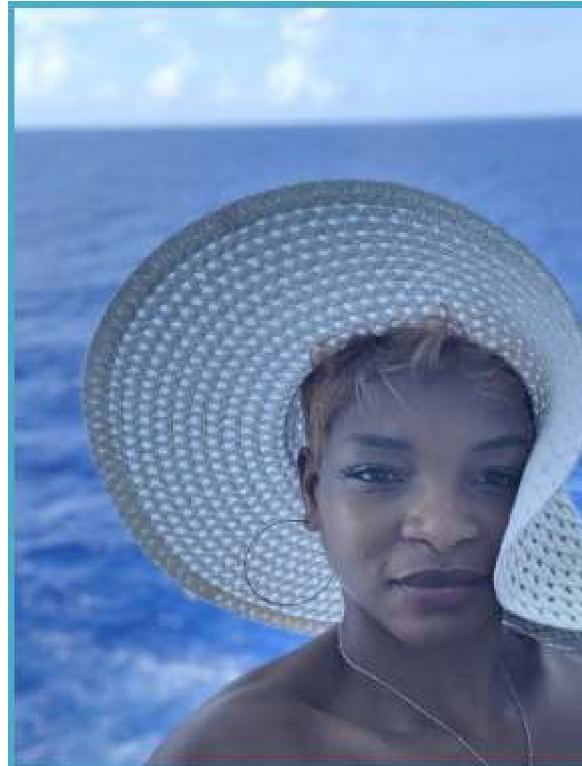


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STEPHANIE'S MEMORABLE TRIP:

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NORMAN'S MEMORABLE TRIP:

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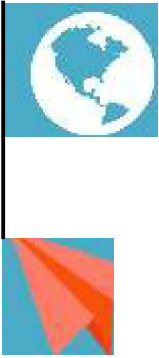
