Vaccination Incentive Program

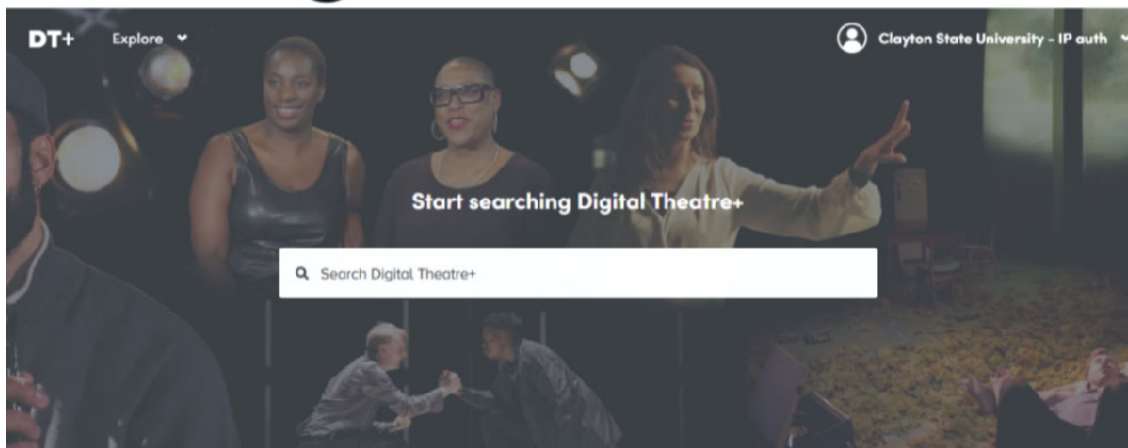
