The State Accounting Office has announced increases in mileage reimbursement rates effective January 1, 2023. The rates are as follows:

Automobile	\$0.625	\$0.655
Motorcycle	\$0.565	\$0.635
Airplane	\$1.515	\$1.74
Tier-2 Rate:	\$0.18	\$0.22
