## Athletic Committee Seeks Input **On Mascot Selection Process**

**Desires Nominations From Campus Community** 

Clayton State College is in need of a mascot. Next year the College will begin intercollegiate athletic competition and a mascot that will truly represent our institution is needed. The mascot selection process will be coordinated by the newly appointed Athletic Committee. This committee is working with the SGA Mascot Committee to implement several proposed activities.

The mascot selection process and guidelines have been established by the Athletic Committee and are listed in the article to the right. Please review this process and use it in the completion of the "Mascot Nominating Forms" that is attached to this Special "Extra" edition of The Bent Tree.

Mascot nominating forms will be distributed in early January and need to be submitted by January 22. These should be turned in at the Dean of Students Office (C-57) by 6:00 p.m. that day. The Athletic Committee will conduct a first review of the suggested mascots and rationales in early February and the "forums" and opinion polls will take

#### Process/Guidelines For The Mascot Nominating Process As Established By The Athletic Committee

The newly appointed Athletic Committee has established a process and guidelines for the mascot selection process. They are as follows:

1. Input will be sought from individual students and faculty (for both mascot name and reasons why CSC should have that particular mascot).

2. Establish appropriate rationale for the selection of the mascot. In particular the mascot should reflect/symbolize what the College represents (e.g., symbolize the beauty of the campus and the academic quality, excellence, and strength of its programs). Furthermore, in so far as possible, the mascot should not be identical to the major 4-AAAA high school mascots in our service area or those colleges and schools within the state that CSC is most likely to compete against (see listing on the reverse side of this special edition). The mascot should be one that is easily marketable and in

3. The top six-twelve selections will be determined by the committee, from the suggestions submitted (using the above rationale).

4. Further input from students and faculty will be sought through "forums" as to which of these are the top selections and rationales.

5. An opinion poll on these top selections, to come up with the top three choices, will be conducted among the student body and faculty.

6. The committee will review all the suggestions and submit threesix mascot suggestions and rationales to the President.

Mascot nominating forms will be distributed in early January and need to be submitted by January 22. These should be turned in at the Dean of Students Office (C-57) by 6:00 p.m. that day. The Athletic Committee will conduct a first review of the suggested mascots and rationales in early February and the "forums" and opinion polls will take place in mid February. The committee will make their recommendations to President Downs in late February.
